Please allow me to inform you that we have two scheduled trips in a couple of weeks: to the USA on August 4, 2013 (tickets are attached) and to Canada on August 12, 2013 (we have purchased tickets and reserved hotel rooms, non-refundable).

We intend to go to Canada without returning to Russia, so Mrs Solzhenitsyna will not be able to get her visa in the period of August 4-12, 2013, if you do not issue it earlier, where possible.
