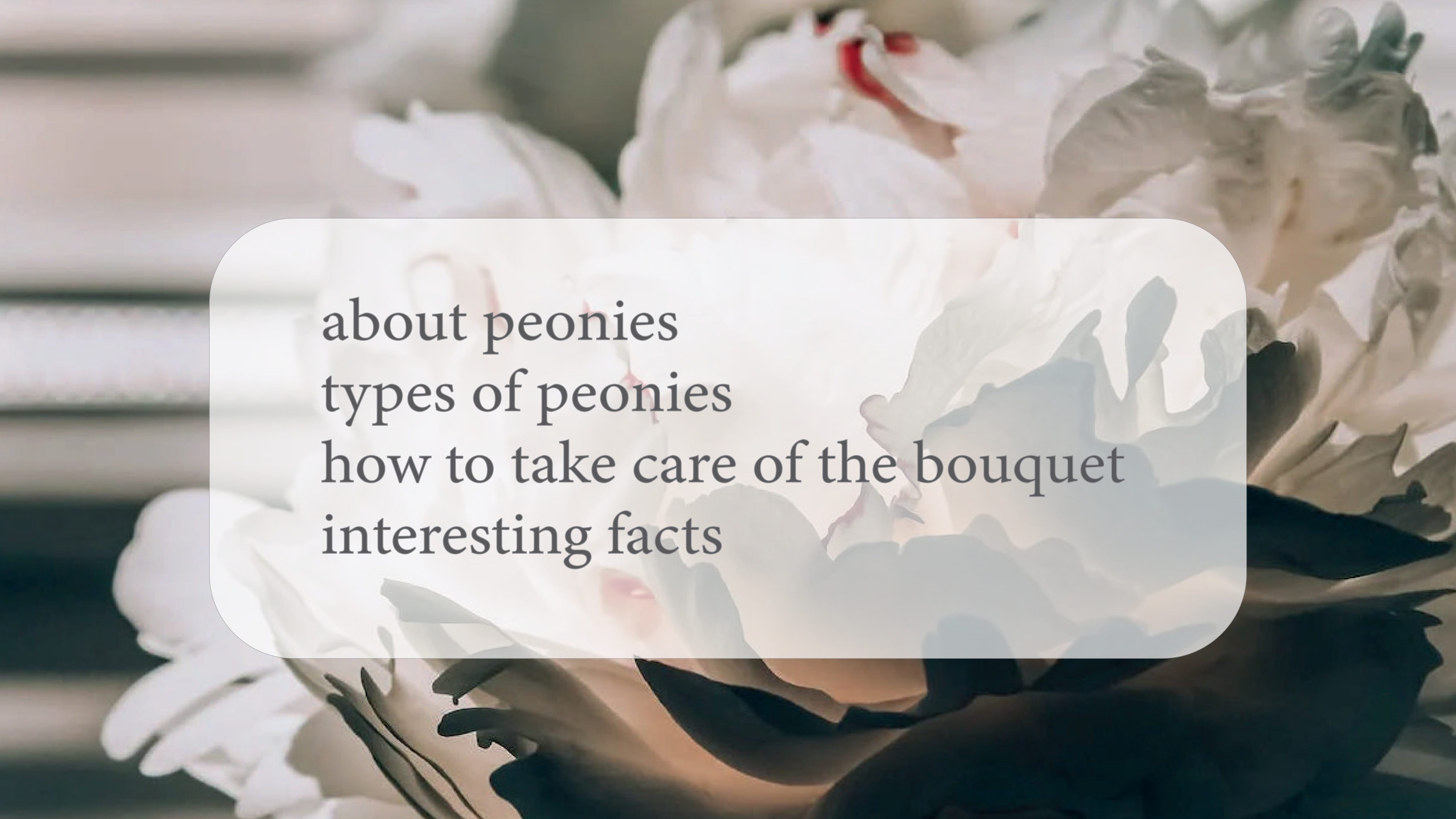

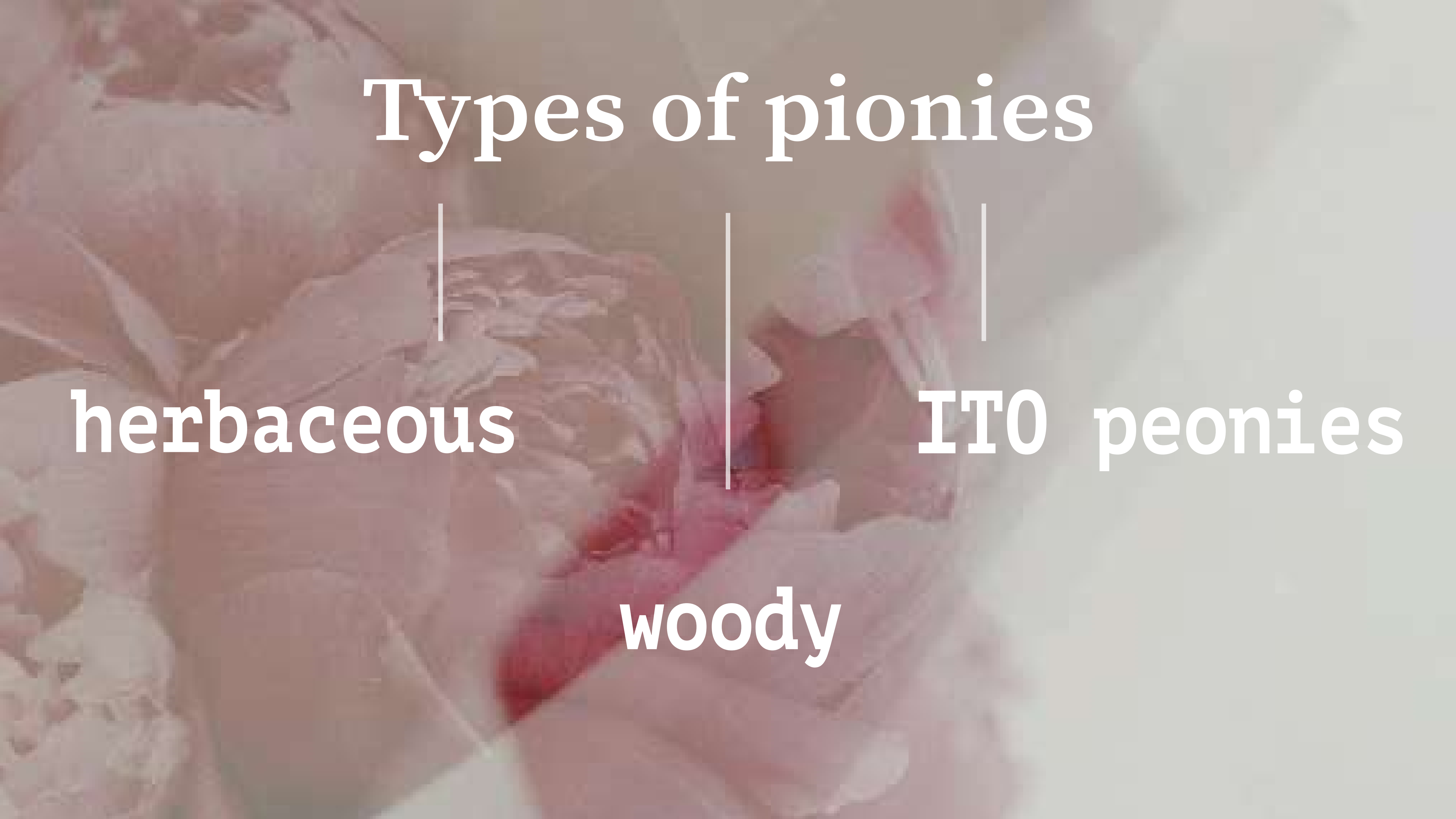

The higher the
air temperature,
the faster the
peonies bloom.

If you want to
keep the buds
unopened, put
the composition in
any cool place:
refrigerator, balcony,
cellar. But make
sure that the
temperature
does not fall
below 5 degrees.

To spread the sweet
floral scent throughout
the room, wrap each
bud in plastic overnight.
In the morning, the
packaging must be
removed, otherwise
the flowers will
“suffocate”.
