TO SAVE AT ANY COST



This young woman's name is Daria. She is only 24 years old, and unfortunately her life is not easy. There was no work in her village, and like many Ukrainians, Daria went to the Czech Republic to earn money. There she met a man, of whom she recalls with pain and does not want to say anything. All we know is that she got pregnant and the man rejected her and the baby. Daria made the decision to return to Ukraine, give birth to her child here, and to keep it in the maternity hospital.



Thank God, the doctors persuaded the unfortunate woman to keep the baby. They also turned to the New Life Christian Mission for help. Volunteers immediately withdrew and took the girl and child, providing them with shelter at the Mother and Child Home. Now Daria is recovering mentally and the baby is not motherless.



VENTILATION SYSTEM INSTALLATION

To help women and children who found themselves in difficult situation, the New Life Christian Mission have built the Mother and Child Home near Odessa.

The building is completely built and is at the final stage. Volunteers installed a ventilation system in the kitchen, which will be able to meet the needs of 300-500 people including habitants of the city for refugees and displaced persons.





EXPANSION OF TOWN FOR REFUGEES



With God's help and the support of our partners, the Mission purchased a second plot of land to expand the town and construction works are underway there. Modular toilets and showers were also installed in the town this month.

FACES OF TOWN FOR REFUGEES

«My name is Tatyana, I am a single mother and I have three children: Sasha (5 years old), Zhenya (3 years old), and Maxim (2 years old). We fled from Kherson. A rocket hit our neighbor's house and a wave hit our house too: half of it was left behind and half was swept away. We had nowhere to live. We wore whatever clothes we had and came to the town for refugees near Odessa. Thank God we were not left on the street. In the town we were given everything we needed: clothes and hygiene products and also toys for children. The house is warm and comfortable. Me and my children are calm now and in safety.»
