Morning: ICC Tower and Elements Mall



In the morning you can go to the ICC Tower and Elements Mall. These buildings are placed on the Kowloon Station and it is really easy to get there by MTR, that is why we suggest you these attractions as a first point of the route. The tower is famous for its incredibly beautiful view from the top and extremely nice exterior. Midday: Victoria's Harbour

Afternoon: Victoria Peak



The most important point is Victoria Peak, the highest point in Hong Kong. As they say, if you want to visit a lot of places in this city, you should start from Peak.

There is a large observation deck at the peak tower, called Sky Terrace 148, where you can either have lunch or buy some souvenirs. Also you can see spectacular views from the observation deck of the Road Lugard, Lions View Point Pavilion, as well as on the viewing terrace of the Peak Gallery. For expanded prospects take a walk along the Peak Circle Walk. This is your opportunity to capture breathtaking moments so do not omit the Peak and make your trip really wonderful. People admit that the most exciting part of the tour around the Peck is an old tram, going by which you will pass skyscrapers and see it from unexpectedly amazing sides.

Evening: The Symphony Of Lights



Every evening you can see how 47 great buildings participate in the lights show and send light rays into the sky, making Hong Kong literally the most colourful city. The best places to observe the performing - Avenue of Stars on the waterfront of Tsim Sha Tsui promenade near the water, the Golden Bauhinia Square in Wan Chai and tourist ferries that ply the Victoria harbor.
