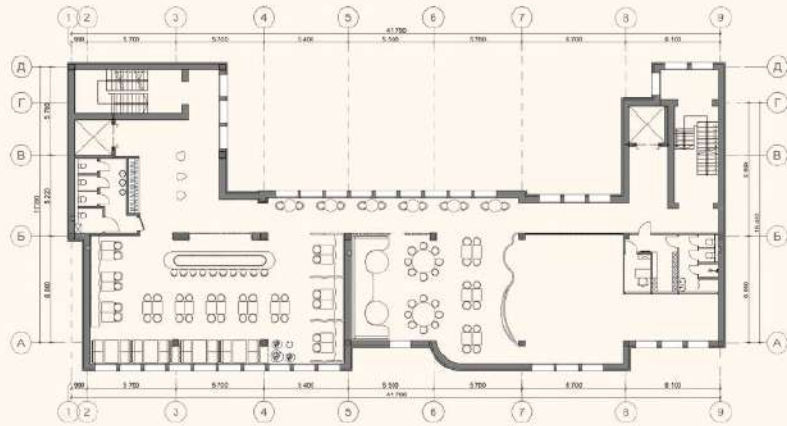
A restaurant of modern Ukrainian cuisine, created using motifs of Ukrainian ceramics. Ukrainian ceramics are characterized by non-ideal shapes, curved smooth lines, natural shades, aesthetically worn texture - these features are also reflected in the interior design of the restaurant. Only natural materials are used in the design, including clay, wood, stone, linen, organic cotton... The main colors of this space are natural beige shades, warm milk color, earthy, honey and cornflower as an accent. This restaurant gives a feeling of slowing down, rest and peace, which are so important in our time. Interior design combines traditions and modern design language.

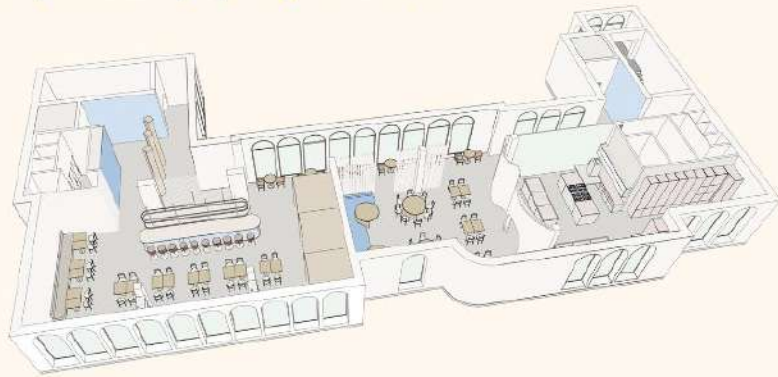

There are a total of 112 seats in the dining rooms and 10 seats in the bar. The kitchen of the restaurant is open on one side, and glazed on the another one, so visitors can watch the process of preparing their dishes.

The interior decoration is similar to the traditional dwelling of Ukrainians with its naive sculptural forms and a technique with a history, i.e. rolling, which was used to create houses "mazanky" by our ancestors. Since the main material is clay, most of the elements are created with it. For example, the walls and ceiling are decorated with sculptural materials and techniques, the smoothness and softness of its form creates an atmosphere of peace and comfort.
