

Volodymyr Zelenskiy reacted to the news about rocket hits on his native city

On September, 14, the massive rocket attack on the city Kryvyi Rih took place. Seven cruise missiles damaged the dam of the Karachunivske Reservoir, resulting in a serious threat of flooding in the city by the water from the river Inhulec.

Ukrainian president Volodymyr Zelenskiy in his regular night video message told the words that might become one of the most famous war quotes: "History is written by people, never by savages". As usual, he expressed confidence in Ukrainian victory, and added, that Russian attempts to intimidate civilians only laid bare their true weakness.

The missile attack caused the level of the Inhulec river to rise from 1m to about 2m. More than 100 houses were flooded. The city authorities urgently organized the partial evacuation of the inhabitants to safer areas.
