All kinds of vaccinations are recommended They protect your child from dangerous diseases (Tuberculosis, poliomyelitis, pertussis, diphtheria, tetanus, hepatitis B, meningitis, pneumococcal infection, smallpox and German smallpox, viral diarrhea).

Do not worry if your child has a fever after vaccination, or if a child has his vaccination site swollen. These are signs of the body response to vaccination. You can apply cold gauzes on the swollen site.

The certificate is important, it should be kept safe. Please keep this certificate about yourself when visiting any medical institution or entering a school.

We encourage you to specify the exact age of a child.
