smallpox and German smallpox, viral diarrhea).

Do not worry if your child has  
a fever after vaccination, or if a child has his vaccination  
site swollen. These are signs of the body response  
to vaccination. You can apply cold gauzes  
on the swollen site.

visiting any medical institution or entering  
a school.
