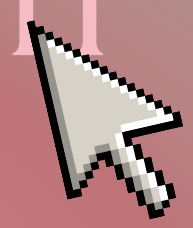
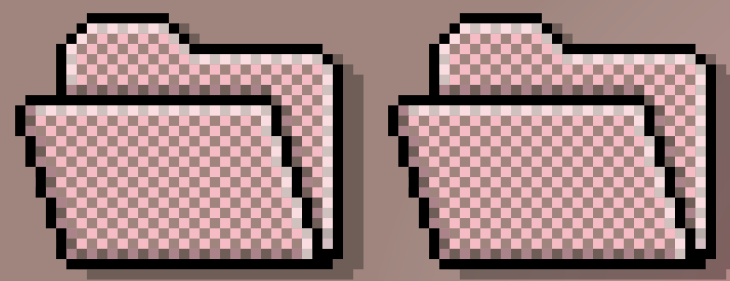

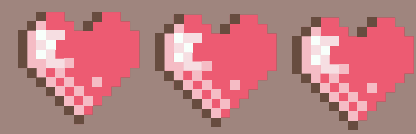

## Rules

- to work → worked
- to translate → translated
- to agree → agreed
- to study → studied
- to play → played
- to stop → stopped
- to relax → relaxed

- cry - cried - y → i
- carry - carried - y → i
- work- worked - no e
- hope - hoped - no e
- stop - stopped - if you speak a short vowel → doubling
- drop -dropped - if you speak a short vowel → doubling
