## First impression is the last impression.

We meet people everywhere. We look at them, size them up and end up judging them at first sight. Sometimes it is a good impression, sometimes very unpleasant and repulsive. But, all we need to know about this first impression is that it is most of all false, and doesn't characterize a person at all.

For instance, people often judge others by their appearance. First of all, nice and fashionable clothes may attract people's attention, but it will only describe your way of style, not your personality. Sometimes a humble and unnoticeable person, dressed up in ordinary clothes, may be a very intelligent and interesting individual. And rude, narrow — minded people seem to mask their rotten souls by wearing expensive and vivid ones. But even these thoughts may be mistakable until you'll get to know the person closer.

Second, some unpredictable circumstances can make the person behave the way he or she did. People psychology is very complicated and fragile. If some person, for instance, dared to ignore your request to show the way to the Central Station in another city, don't hurry to have a grouch on him and consider him as being rude. He may be very busy, or in a hurry, or simply lost in thought. There are many other possible variants he had to behave in such a way.

And third of all, on first acquaintances, people tend to lie in order to seem better or, simply, to make the person like them. In this case, the first impression will later turn into the whole disappointment. As a result, the nice and pleasant man happened to be a liar and brutal show – off. Earlier or later the truth will always out.

To sum up, there are no good or bad impressions, but wrong ones. Before judging the person, try to focus on yourself and your behavior. Only time will tell who is who.
