TWENTY ONE PILOTS (TØP) IS MORE THAN JUST MUSIC. IT'S A UNIVERSE CREATED BY TYLER JOSEPH AND JOSH DUN, WHERE LYRICS ARE THE KEY TO A COMPLEX STORY ABOUT DOUBT, MENTAL HEALTH, AND THE SEARCH FOR FREEDOM. THEIR WORK IS AN OPEN DIALOGUE WITH THE "CLIQUE".



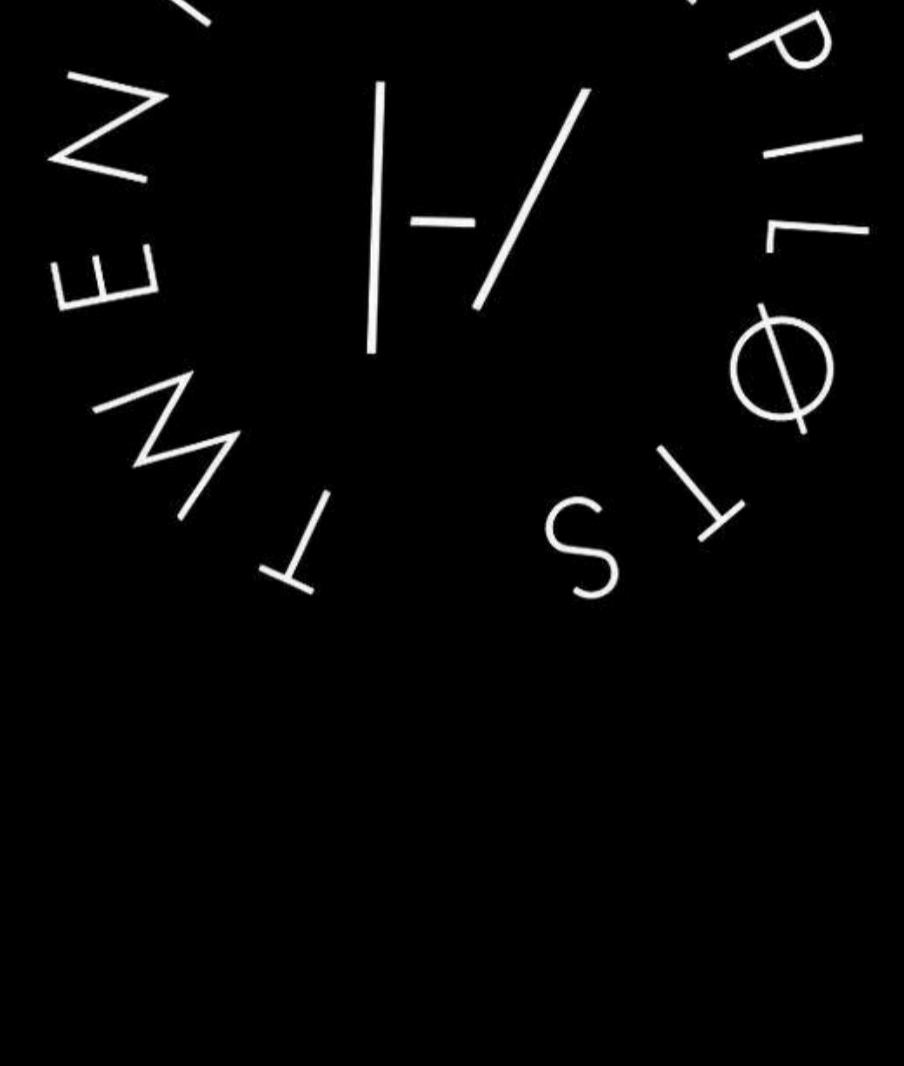
JOSH DUN (DRUMMER): A DYNAMIC, ENERGETIC PERFORMER, HIS DRUMMING SETS AN UNRIVALED ENERGY. HIS ROLE IN THE DUO IS TO SUPPORT, EMBODY STRENGTH AND HOPE, AND COUNTER TYLER'S INNER DOUBTS.

TYLER JOSEPH (FRONTMAN): VOCALIST, SONGWRITER, PIANIST. A KEY FIGURE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE BAND'S LORE (BLURRYFACE, CLANCY). HIS LYRICS ARE DEEP INTROSPECTION, PHILOSOPHICAL AND SPIRITUAL EXPLORATIONS.

Their goal is not just to create music, but to help people get through dark times and find meaning in their own emotions.

The band was founded in 2009 in Columbus, Ohio. Initially, the lineup consisted of three musicians, but since 2011 the group has become a duo - Tyler Joseph (vocals, keyboards, lyrics) and Josh Dun (drums).

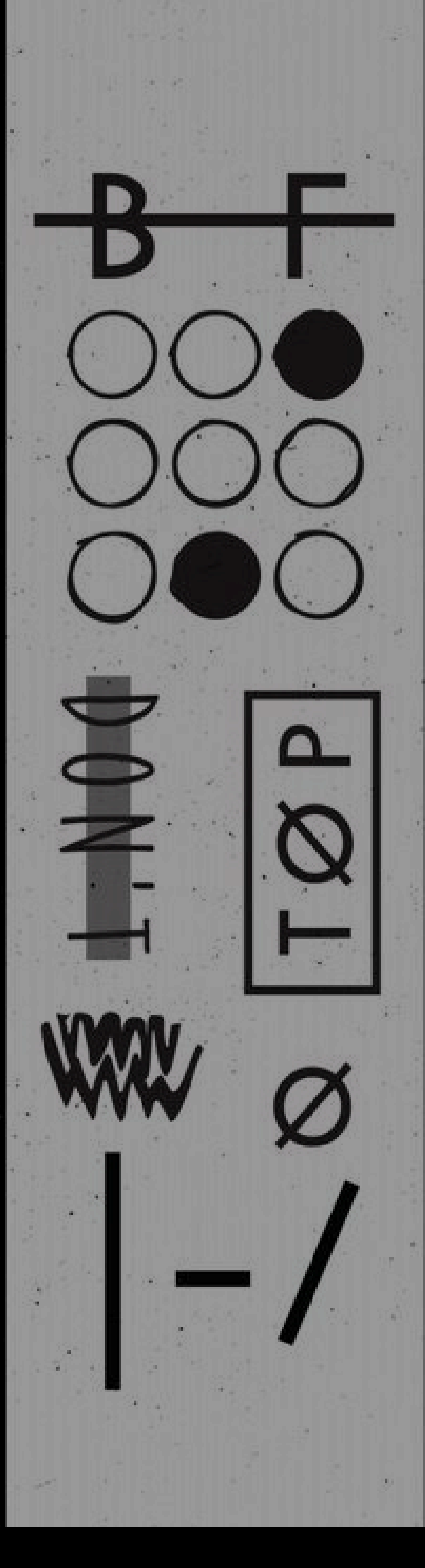


In 2015, the album "Blurryface" was released, which became a turning point in the band's career.

Blurryface's image is the embodiment of the inner fears and doubts that every person struggles with. The hit "Stressed Out" turned him into the voice of a generation tired of societal expectations and pressures.

Twenty One Pilots have always written more than just songs, but stories about anxiety, depression, and finding yourself. Tyler Joseph uses lyrics as therapy — for himself and for his listeners. Their concerts are a dialogue between artist and fans, a gathering of people who feel the same way, even if they don't say it out loud.

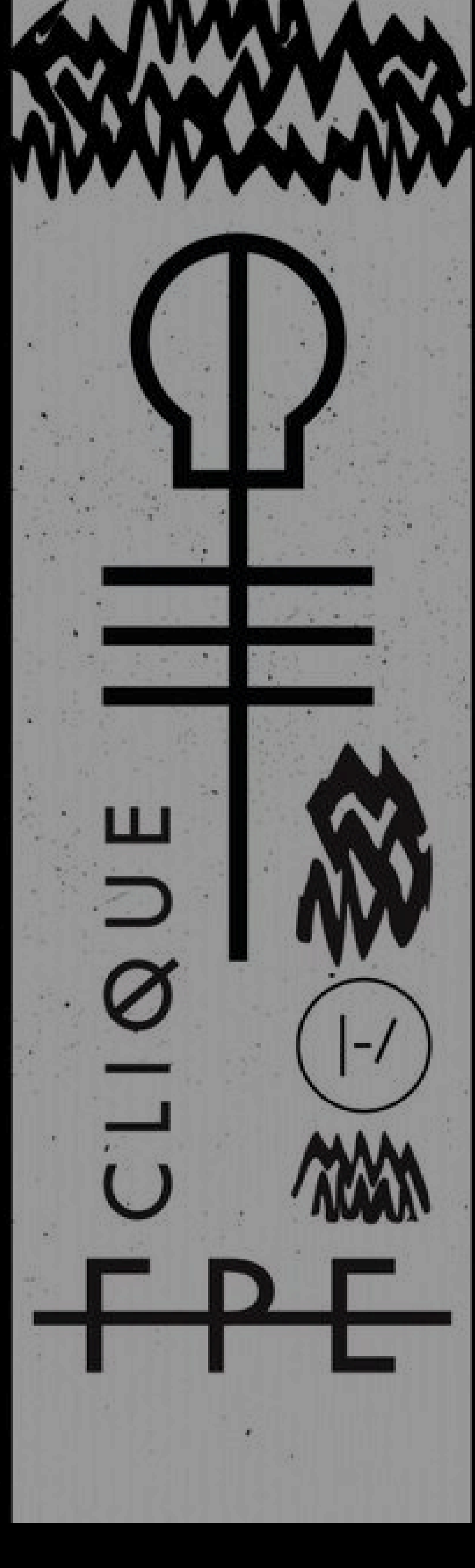
BLURRYFACE



All stages of the band's creativity are accompanied by special symbolism: colors, signs, masks, visual concepts.

Red and black* — the Blurryface era, the struggle with one's own "self".

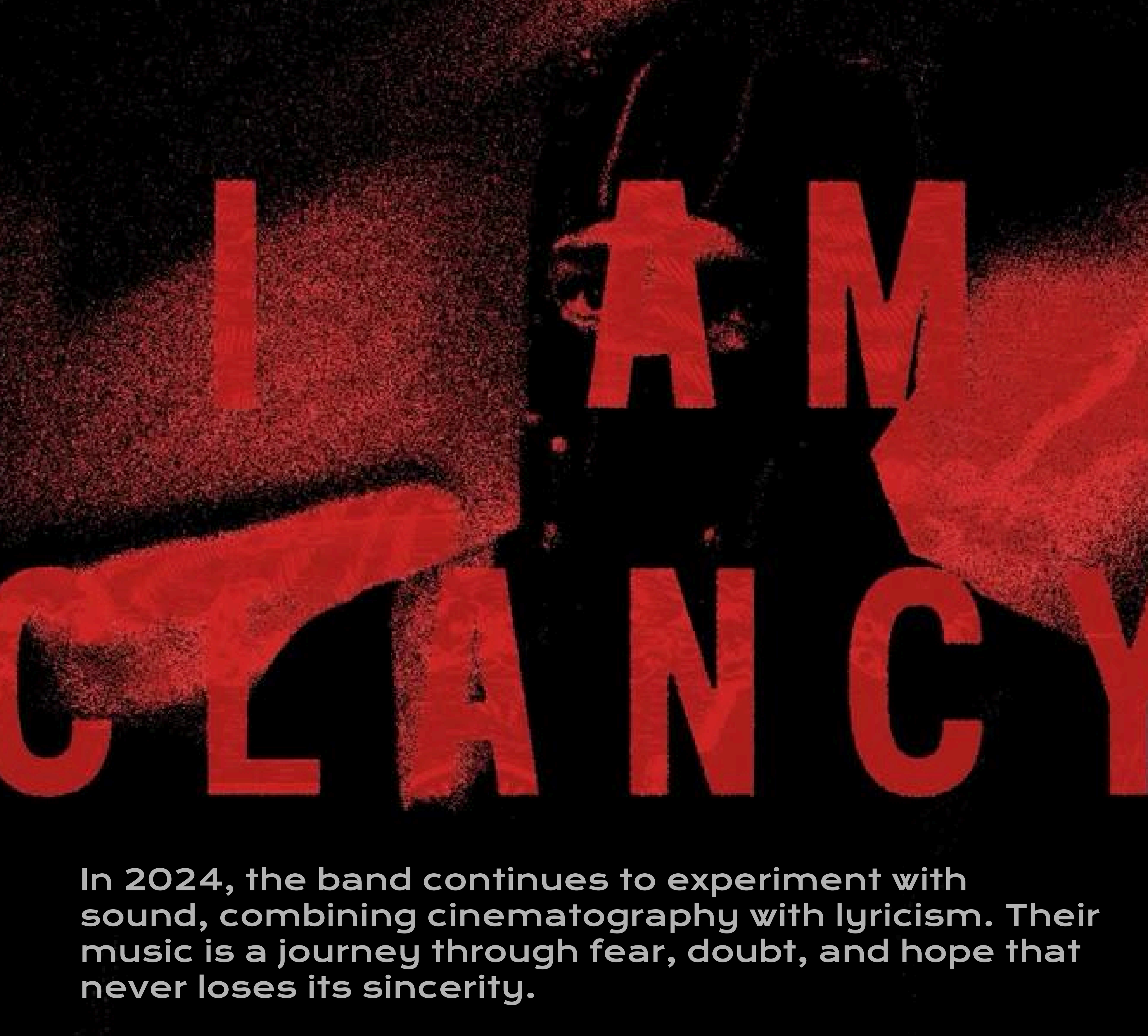
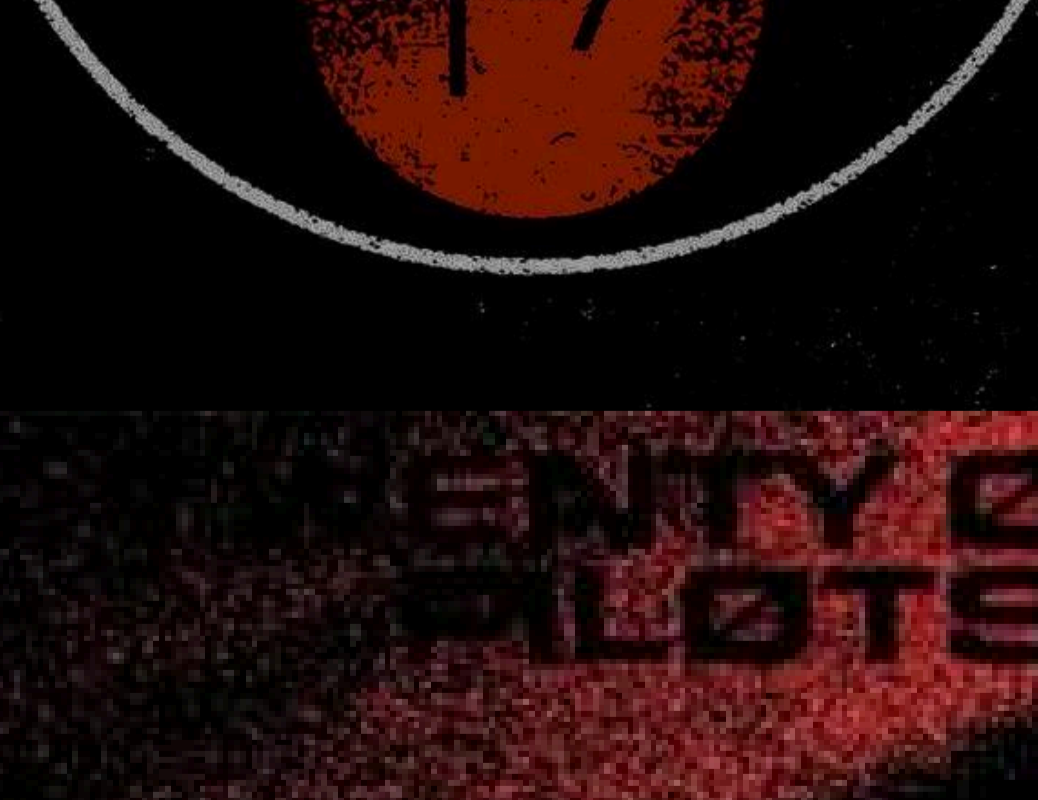
Yellow and black* — the "Trench" period, where the main character Nico seeks freedom from the control of the system. Gray and neon shades* — "Scaled and Icy", a lighter but ironic image of escape into a fictional world.



The fans, known as the Skeleton Clique, have become an integral part of the Twenty One Pilots phenomenon.

They are not just listeners, they are a community of support, trust, and the feeling that "you are not alone."

" Each of the band's concerts becomes a symbolic ritual, where fans draw symbols on their hands, sing along, and share stories of how TØP's music has changed them.



In 2024, the band continues to experiment with sound, combining cinematography with lyricism. Their music is a journey through fear, doubt, and hope that never loses its sincerity.
