Significant Themes in the Novel *To Kill the Mockingbird*

In every piece of art, there are some main themes the author adds to their work with a didactic purpose, and literature is not an exception. The famous novel *To Kill a Mockingbird* by Harper Lee also teems with important messages helping readers to solve some moral issues in their lives. In the book, Lee touches on the topics of (un)justice complexity, educational and knowledge conflict, good and evil themes, and racial discrimination problems, which are eternal themes in literature and society.

The Four Main Themes in *To Kill a Mockingbird*

(Un)Justice Complexity

Undoubtedly, there is no person in the world that did not pay attention to the justice theme while reading the novel *To Kill a Mockingbird*. Here, the main conflict lies in a sad world's rule about justice absence for some people, especially for people belonging to minorities. For instance, "the word "sin" appears fourteen times in the novel" (Stow, 2019, p. 18), and in some cases, its definition is women. Even though the author does not perceive it as something highly negative, inappropriate, and sexist, today everyone understands how much these words are brutal.

Besides, in the novel, not only women but also colored people suffer from injustice and rights inequality. For example, the strongest "evidence" against Tom is his "wrong" skin color and race, which makes him a bad person that deserves the highest punishment for something he did not do. One more character, Mayella, suffers from so-named justice as well—she is a victim of ignorance, and the only thing that makes her situation better is her white skin color. The last fact makes readers return to the subject of injustice to colored people based not on their actions and

behavior patterns, but on their race. Therefore, the book shows readers that the law system is not perfect, and sometimes laws can lead people to unfair accusations, which Tom had to know by himself.

Educational and Knowledge Conflict

In the novel *To Kill a Mockingbird*, the reader sees that being formally educated does not mean being intelligent and having true knowledge of the studied subject. At school, children develop skills to accept the world's anger and injustice while gaining factual information they are not interested in. That is why Scout gets more useful advice from her father Atticus—he realizes that children can study only “when they show the faintest symptom of wanting an education” (Lee, 1960, p. 27). Consequently, children do not have enough motivation to study, and teachers do nothing to encourage students' potential.

Therefore, Lee describes the theme of education and knowledge as one of the most important conflicts because joyful and smart studying is the only way to learn new skills. *To Kill a Mockingbird* teaches readers the value of empathy and also offers great learning opportunities. For example, discussion, historical research, and role-playing allow students to delve into these issues and evaluate them and the work itself.

Good Versus Evil Theme

People are not capable to become mature without knowing what is good and what is evil, because not everything is perfect outside a person's home. Therefore, the main protagonist of Lee's book *To Kill a Mockingbird* had to learn all world's bad things as well as good ones. Notwithstanding, life is never black or white, so no one can tell for sure whether a person angel or a demon.

For example, the novel's voice, Atticus, mixes both good and bad in his personality, which is impossible at first sight—not everyone may tell why this character is not purely positive. Even though Atticus says that it is a sin to kill a mockingbird because it does anything but sing and makes people happier with its song, there is some darkness in these words. According to Atticus, the

mockingbird is a symbol of innocence, nonetheless, such a “relationship between form and content” (Vercellone & Tedesco, 2020, p. 244) is hard to call “correct”. The point is that killing everything and everyone in this world should be perceived as a sin, no matter if it is a mockingbird, kiwi, or woodpecker.

Therefore, Atticus should not have this selective good attitude to human creatures treating white people better than colorful ones. It is not clear whether the writer did it consciously, but thanks to mentioned character’s views, readers do not perceive Atticus as a totally positive character. As a result, readers learn not to divide the world into black and white, because not everything is so simple and it is wrong to call a person completely “right” or “wrong”.

Racial Discrimination Problem

Racial discrimination is a complex topic in the USA, so it has already been touched on in the previous paragraphs, but some deep details should be mentioned. Today, there are still people who do not understand that everyone should have equal rights and that everybody ought to be treated honorably. For this reason, the last but not least topic of the essay is negative beliefs about colorful people.

In the book, there is a humiliating thesis about the aristocratism of the white population while colorful men depicted as men of lower grades. Even Atticus who is a moral authority with numerous good human qualities, do have offensive segregation and racist views (Potyk & White, 2020). Unfortunately, Lee did not represent it as something wrong and unbelievable for the intelligent and progressive society.

The author wrote this novel from her white “elite” perspective, but this does not mean that readers have to agree with such insulting statements. In addition, the city characters live in, does not offer people of color proper workplaces and their jobs list is quite poor. Mostly, they work as servants and garbage collectors while white people can choose to work where they want, so no wonder, why racial prejudice is the main theme of the book.

Conclusion

To sum everything up, the novel *To Kill a Mockingbird* is full of various themes such as (un)justice complexity, educational and knowledge conflict, good and evil themes, and racial discrimination problems. In this essay, all mentioned themes were analyzed with references to characters' words and actions in different novel scenes. Moreover, people still should talk about these subjects discussing it while reading old books and films as everyone needs to know how not to repeat the mistakes of the past. That is the only way every person can be treated correctly and justly no matter what is his skin color, sex, age, weight, and any other feature that does not identify his soul, talent, and value. In this way, *To Kill a Mockingbird* teaches readers about bravery, inequality, injustice, racism, and oppression, showing the importance of not judging people by what they are. Since, first of all, men deserve to be respected for being men, and all their features, victories, and any other characteristics ought to go behind.
